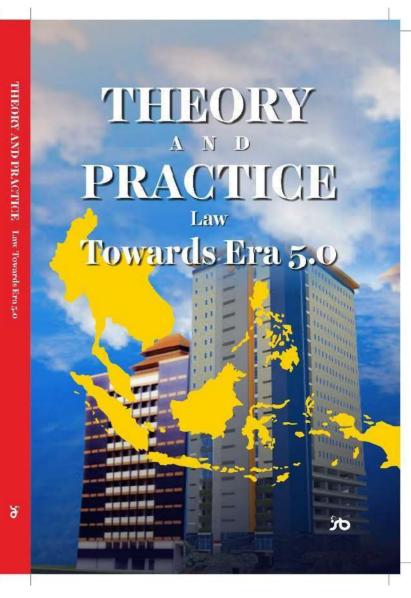

Sanksi Pelanggaran Pasal 113 Undang-Undang Republik Indonesia Nomor 28 Tahun 2014 Tentang Hak Cipta

Introduction

The Indonesian National Police (Polri) is one of the government agencies in Indonesia that has an important role in maintaining public security and order (Kapolri, 2018). Like main duties of the National Police are as stated in the Law. No. 2 of 2002 article 13 which reads:

"The main duties of the National Police are to protect, protect, serve the community, and enforce the law, uphold public security and order, and carry out protection, protection, and service in orderly, orderly, and peaceful community activities."

The National Police of the Republic of Indonesia is a state instrument that plays a role in maintaining public security and order, enforcing the law, and providing protection, protection, and services to the community in the context of maintaining internal security. Like success of the National Police in carrying out its basic duties is determined by the extent of public trust in the police organization.

Trust is basically a psychological state of a person in carrying out activities, in this case trust in police performance. Public trust will provide support in the implementation of police duties. L'rust also indicates a person's willingness to rely on others where one has faith in that person. L'rust is also a mental state that is based on a person's situation and social context. In order to increase public trust in the police, the Chief of Police takes policies to improve police operational performance in maintaining public security and order, law enforcement, protection and community services. In addition, the Chief of Police also emphasized the importanceof improving the culture of the police organization so that the attitudes and behaviors of police members are in accordance with the rules and norms that apply in society. Both activities are further supported by proper media management. L'he media currently has a strategic role in determining the level of public trust in an organization / government institution including the police.

L'he media has the ability to structure issues in society. Walter Lippman says that "Society does not respond to actual events in its environment, but to images in our heads called pseudoenvironment. Because the actual environment is too large, too complex and too demanding for direct contact and not equipped with so many permutations and combinations. L'he

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media is able to provide simple models that can stimulate the response of the community by formulating an agenda.

Lhe National Police Public Relations Lask Force has a very central role in supporting media management activities to increase public trust in the National Police. L'his is like thefunction of public relations which has universal objectives including: 1) creating public understanding; 2) create public confidence (public trust in the company / organization); 3) create public support (there is an element of support from the public for the company / organization) both in material and spiritual forms; and fi) Creating public coorperation (cooperation from the public to the company / organization).

The implementation of one of the tasks in terms of service includes providing information to the public which can be called public information. One of the National Police Work Units (Satker) tasked with providing public information services is the Police Public Relations Work Unit.

The role of the National Police Public Relations Lask Force in delivering public information is very important to support transparency and accountability of the National Police as a government institution responsible for security and order. L'herefore, it is necessary to continue to evaluate and develop the relationship between the working procedures of the National Police Public Relations Work Unit in delivering public information, including the working relationship with the Police Bareskrim, in order to meet the public's needs for fast, precise, and accurate information. L'he National Police Public Relations L'ask Force acts as the spearhead in providing public information to the public. L'his L'ask Force is tasked with conveying information on Polri activities to the public, both through online media, mainstream media and through social media. In this case, the National Police Public Relations Unit cooperates more with the National Police Criminal Investigation Agency (Bareskrim) than with other task forces.

In terms of carrying out its duties, providing public information to the public related to the duties of the National Police in carrying out the main duties of the National Police, still, there are several obstacles, including due to the unsmooth flow of information from the relevant Satker in this case the Police Criminal Investigation with the Police Public Relations Work Unit. L'herefore, in 2018, Police Regulation Number 3 of 2018 concerning the Working Procedures of the Police Public Relations Work Unit with the Police Bareskrim in Public Information Services, which aims to improve coordination and collaboration between the National Police Public Relations Work Unit and the National Police Criminal Investigation in delivering public information.

However, the implementation of this regulation still faces several obstacles, such as a lack of communication and coordination between the two parties, a lack of understanding of the regulation, and the absence of guidelines. Like mechanism for requesting information to the Criminal Investigation Unit (Bareskrim Polri) is often deadlocked. Likerefore, efforts are needed to overcome these obstacles, such as improving communication and coordination between the two parties, improving understanding of the regulations, and improving human resources and technology.

The implementation of information needs is difficult in terms of the speed of providing initial information, which is a task that cannot be solved by any Polri spokesperson. L'his includes service to journalists for access to information. With the homework that cannot be completed by the Polri Public Relations Division, sometimes a lot of hoax or false information appears. Given that information develops quickly without being accompanied by a quick statement according to the facts from the Public Relations.

To overcome the constraints, several efforts need to be made, including :

- 1. Improve communication and coordination between the Polri Public Relations Unit and Bareskrim Polri through regular meetings and coordination meetings.
- 2. Improve understanding of the regulation through socialization and training.

Anwar's research (2020) found that the implementation of the regulation still experienced obstacles in terms of a lack of coordination and communication between the Polri Public Relations Unit and Bareskrim Polri and a lack of understanding of the regulation (Anwar, 2020). L'he implementation of the regulation is still hampered by a lack of human resources and technology. Effective coordination and collaboration between the Polri Public Relations Unit and Bareskrim Polri is essential in the delivery of public information (Handayani, 2019). L'he implementation is still less than optimal in terms of understanding and human resource support. L'herefore, there are still many obstacles in terms of lack of coordination and communication between the Polri Public Relations Unit and Bareskrim Polri.

To evaluate the implementation of Police Regulation No. 3/2018 on the Working Procedures of the Public Relations Unit with Bareskrim Polri in Public Information Services. Some examples are research by Anwar (2020) and Handayani (2019). Like results of these studies show that the implementation of the regulation still experiences several obstacles, such as a lackof coordination and communication between the Polri Public

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Relations Unit and Bareskrim Polri, a lack of understanding of the regulation, and a shortage of human resources and technology.

Discussion

Muhamad Haripin¹⁰, a public policy expert from Padjajaran University, stated that Polri should pay attention to accountability in providing public information. According to him, Polri must ensure that any public information provided can be accounted for and is in accordance with the principles of accountability.

From the experts' opinions above, it can be concluded that Polri must pay attention to transparency and accountabilityin its public information services. Polri must ensure that any information provided to the public is in accordance with the facts and does not deviate from the truth. In addition, Polri must also ensure that the decision-making process in providing public information is in accordance with the principles of transparency and accountability. Polri must pay attention to the quality of public information provided, the use of information technology

Rizky Ananda Putra¹¹, a public policy observer from the University of Indonesia, stated that efforts to improve the implementation of the working relationship between the Polri Public Relations Unit and Bareskrim Polri in public information services are very important to ensure that Police Regulation No. 3/2018 can be implemented properly. According to him, the implementation should be done by optimizing the roles and responsibilities of each work unit and improving coordination between the two work units.

Dian Septiari¹², a public policy observer from the University of Indonesia, stated that efforts to improve the implementation of the working relationship between the Polri Public Relations Unit and Bareskrim Polri in providing public information services are very important to improve Polri's transparency and accountability in providing public information services. According to him, the implementation should be done by improving coordination between the two units and ensuring that the working procedures are in accordance with Police Regulation No. 3/2018.

Yudi Latif¹³, a public policy expert from Gadjah Mada University, stated that efforts to improve the implementation of the working relationship between the Polri Public Relations Unit and Bareskrim Polri in public information services are very important to ensure that Polri provides quality public information services that can be trusted by the public. According to him, the implementation should be done by optimizing the roles and responsibilities of each work unit, improving coordination between the two work units, and improving the quality of public information services.

AriefBudiman^{1fi},apublicmanagementexpertfromtheUniversity of Indonesia, stated that efforts to improve the implementation of the working relationship between the Polri Public Relations Unit and Bareskrim Polri in providing public information services is very important to improve the effectiveness and efficiency of Polri in providing public information services. According to him, this should be done by improving coordination between the two units, optimizing the roles and responsibilities of each unit, and increasing Polri's transparency and accountability in providing public information services.

From the experts' opinions above, it can be concluded that efforts to improve the implementation of the working relationship between Polri's Public Relations Unit and Bareskrim Polri in providing public information services are essential to ensure that Police Regulation No. 3/2018 can be implemented properly, improve Polri's transparency and accountability in providing public information services, provide quality public information services that can be trusted by the public, improve Polri's effectiveness and efficiency in providing public information services, and ensure that Polri complies with applicable laws and regulations. L'he implementation should be carried out by improving coordination between the two units, optimizing the roles and responsibilities of each unit, improving the quality of public information services, optimizing the use of information technology, and increasing Polri's transparency and accountability in providing public information services. L'hus, Polri can fulfill its duties and responsibilities in providing effective and efficient public information services that can be trusted by the public.

Analysis of Efforts to Improve the Implementation of the Relationship between Polri's Public Relations Unit and Bareskrim Polri in Public Information Services

To improve the implementation of the working relationship between the Polri Public Relations Unit and Bareskrim Polri in providing public information services in accordance with Police Regulation No. 3/2018, Polri can make several efforts, including:

Increase human resource capacity

The first effort Polri can make is to improve the capacity of its human resources in providing public information services. Polri can provide training and education to its human resources so that they have adequate competence and skills in providing public information services. Improving human resource capacity is an effort to improve the quality and competence of human resources in an organization or society.

Lo improve the capacity of human resources is very important to improve the effectiveness and efficiency of organizations or communities, improve competitiveness in the era of globalization, improve the quality of public services, ensure that laws and regulations can be implemented properly, and improve the quality of public policies. Such efforts should be made by providing training, education, and skills development to human resources as well as increasing transparency and public participation in various aspects of the organization or society. L'hus, the organization or society can achieve its desired goals better and more efficiently.

Improve coordination between the National Police Public Relations Unit and the National Police Criminal Investigation Unit (Bareskrim)

The second effort that Polri can make is to improve coordination between Polri's Public Relations Unit and Bareskrim Polri in providing public information services. Polri can conduct regular coordination meetings between the two units to ensure that the public receives accurate and timely information. Improving coordination between Polri's Public Relations Unit and Bareskrim Polri is an effort to improve the relationship and cooperation between the two units in providing public information services.

Improving coordination between Polri's Public Relations Unit and Bareskrim Polri is essential to ensure that Polri's public information services can be carried out properly and transparently, improve Polri's transparency and accountability in providing public information services, ensure that Police Regulation No. 3/2018 can be implemented properly, improve Polri's effectiveness and efficiency in providing public information services, and ensure that Polri complies with applicable laws and regulations. L'his should be done by improving the planning and reporting system between the two units, improving the quality of public information services, increasing public participation in public information services, optimizing the use of information technology, and increasing Polri's transparency and accountability in providing public information services. By doing so, Polri can achieve its goal of providing better public information services to the public and strengthen Polri's positive image in the eyes of the public.

Increase the use of information technology

The third effort Polri can make is to increase the use of information technology in providing public information services. Polri can utilize existing information technology to simplify the public information request process and handling procedures. Polri can also utilize information technology to disseminate public information more effectively and efficiently. Increasing the use of information technology is an effort to improve the effectiveness and efficiency of information management and business processes. L'he following is a detailed explanation according to experts on the importance of improving the use of information technology:

To improve the use of information technology is essential to improve the competitiveness of organizations or communities in the digital era, improve the effectiveness and efficiency of public services, improve the transparency and accountability of organizations or communities, improve the efficiency and effectiveness of the management of organizational or community resources, and ensure that laws and regulations can be implemented properly. Such efforts should be made by improving access to and skills in the use of information technology, optimizing the use of information technology in the management of information and business processes, increasing community participation in decision-making, optimizing the use of information technology in the management of human, financial, and material resources, and increasing transparency and community participation in legal processes. L'hus, the organization or community can achieve the desired goals better and more efficiently and strengthen the positive image of the organization or community in the eyes of the public.

Increase transparency and accountability

The fourth effort that Polri can take is to improve transparency and accountability in providing public information services. Polri can ensure that the decision-making process in providing public information is in accordance with the principles of transparency and accountability. In addition, Polri must also ensure that any information provided to the public is in accordance with the facts and does not deviate from the truth. Improving transparency and accountability is an effort to ensure that organizationsor communities can be held accountable for their actions and decisions and can provide clear and open information to the public.

To improve transparency and accountability is very important to strengthen democracy and public trust, improve the effectiveness and efficiency of public services, improve the efficiency and effectiveness of the management of organizational or community resources, ensure that laws and regulations can be implemented properly. Lhese efforts must be made by increasing public participation in decision-making, improving the quality of public services, improving the system for monitoring and evaluating organizational performance, and increasing public information disclosure. L'hus, the organization or society can better achieve the desired goals and strengthen the positive image of the organization or society in the eyes of the public.

Increase community participation

The fifth measure Polri can take is to increase public participation in the delivery of public information services. Polri can expand access to public information requests and increase public participation in providing feedback and suggestions regarding public information services. Increasing public participation is an effort to involve the public in decision-making and policy implementation related to the public interest.

To increase public participation is very important to strengthen democracy and public trust, improve the effectiveness and efficiency of public services, increase the transparency and accountability of organizations or communities, improve the efficiency and effectiveness of the management of organizations or communities, and ensure that laws and regulations can be implemented properly. Such efforts should be made by improving public access to public information, increasing openness in the decision-making process, involving the public in the process of planning, implementing, and evaluating public policies, increasing public participation in legal processes, and providing a wider and more open space for public participation. L'hus, the organization or community can better achieve the desired goals and strengthen the positive image of the organization or community in the eyes of the public.

Improve monitoring and evaluation

The sixth effort that can be made by the National Police is the statement of supervision of the working procedures of the National Police Public Relations Division with the National Police Criminal Investigation Unit. Polri can conduct regular supervision to ensure that the working procedures are in accordance with Police Regulation No. 3/2018. In addition, Polri should also conduct periodic evaluations to ensure that the public information services provided are effective and efficient. Improving monitoring and evaluation is an effort to ensure that an organization or community can be held accountable for its actions and decisions and can improve its performance on an ongoing basis.

To improve monitoring and evaluation is very important to improve the accountability and transparency of the organization or community, improve the effectiveness and efficiency of public services, improve the efficiency and effectiveness of the management of organizational or community resources, ensure that laws and regulations can be implemented properly. Less efforts should be made by improving the monitoring and evaluation system of organizational performance, increasing public participation in public oversight, providing strict sanctions for rule breakers, providing incentives or rewards for good performance, and developing a clear and transparent reward and punishment system. Lhus, organizations or communities can improve their performance on an ongoing basis and strengthen their positive image in the eyes of the public.

Conclusion

 Based on Police Regulation No. 3/2018 on the Procedure for Providing and Servicing Public Information in the Indonesian National Police, the Polri Public Relations Unit and the National Police Criminal Investigation Unit (Bareskrim Polri) play a very important role in the provision of public information services in Polri. L'he Polri Public Relations Unit is responsible for providing public information to the public regarding Polri activities and performance, while the Police Criminal Investigation Unit is responsible for providing information related to investigation activities. In practice. L'his is done through a process of intense coordination and communication between the two units. In analyzing the working relationship between the Polri Public Relations Unit and Bareskrim Polri in providing public information services, it can be concluded that good cooperation between the two units is essential in ensuring police transparency and accountability to the public. In addition, it should also be noted that public information services must be carried out by prioritizing the principles of openness, truth, and equal access to information for the entire community without discrimination. L'herefore, the Police Public Relations Unit and Bareskrim Polri must work together in a synergistic and coordinative manner, while taking into account the principles set out in Police Regulation No. 3/2018, to ensure good and trustworthy public information services.

2. L'here are several efforts that can be made to improve the working relationship between the Polri Public Relations Unit and Bareskrim Polri in providing public information services in accordance with Police Regulation No. 3/2018. First, there needs to be more intense coordination and communication between the two units. L'his can be done through regular meetings between the Polri Public Relations Unit and Bareskrim Polri to discuss issues related to public information services. In addition, training or workshops can also be conducted to improve communication and cooperation skills between the two units.

Second, it is necessary to increase the awareness and commitment of both Work Units to the principles of openness and transparency in public information services. L'his can be done through socialization and education on the importance of openness and transparency in public information services for the community. L'hird, it is necessary to improve the capacity and management of information in the two Work Units. L'his can be done through the development of information systems that facilitate access to information for the public, as well as training and developing the skills of the staff of the Polri Public Relations Unit and Bareskrim Polri in managing information and responding to requests for information from the public.

Fourth, there should be increased monitoring and evaluation of the performance of the two units in providing public information services. L'his can be done through the establishment of an independent supervisory team or auditor to monitor and evaluate the performance of the two units in providing public information services.

With the implementation of these efforts, it is hoped that the working relationship between the Police Public Relations Unit and the Police Criminal Investigation Unit in providing public information services can be improved and ensure police transparency and accountability to the public.

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
